

Visual & Heritage Arts Entry Guidelines

Registration entry forms must be received in the Quad Cities Senior Olympics office at 1800 3rd Avenue Suite 304, Rock Island IL 61201 or with your entry at CASI (see below). Registration can be mailed or submitted on-line. Please see our website for more details and entry deadlines: www.qcseniorolympics.org

Visual and Heritage Arts entries must be brought to CASI, 1035 W Kimberly Road, Davenport, IA. See Registration form for date. When entries are delivered, you will be asked whether or not the items are for sale. Entries will be displayed at CASI for 1 month from in-take day. Mon – Fri, 8:00 – 5:00

Winners will be announced and medals presented at 7PM, Wednesday, the week of the official games, at an evening reception at the CASI facility. Medals will also be available at the Senior Olympics Headquarters, located on the Augusta College campus, Rock Island, on Friday and Saturday, during Headquarters hours. See the registration packet.

Entries should be picked from CASI in July. You will be notified of the date when you bring your entry in, but if you don't catch the date, you may call the QCSO office or email the event manager, Rhonda Elsbury, relsbur@yahoo.com.

General Rules for all Visual & Heritage Entries

1. All entries must be the original work of the entering artist.
2. Work must have been completed within three years of the entry date and cannot be entered more than once.
3. Participants must have been 50 years of age at the time the work was completed.
4. Limit of one Art entry per participant, per category.
5. Work to be hung must be framed, wired, and ready for hanging.
6. Identification: Artist's name and title of entry, if applicable, must appear or be attached to entry. This can be in form of sticker on back or a 3X5 card accompanying.
7. Fine-craft needlework patterns may be used, but ceramic pieces from molds will not be accepted.
8. Event Manager reserves the right to categorize entries between professional and/or non-professional work for sake of fairness in judging.
